

HOW TO USE YOUR CARTS

- Use the **TAN WHEELED CART FOR GARBAGE ONLY**.
- Use the **GREEN WHEELED CART FOR RECYCLING ONLY**.
- Items that cannot fit inside the cart may be placed 3 feet away from the cart for collection.
- Bulk items may be placed at the curb (3 feet from the carts) on the same day as garbage collection. Items that cannot be loaded in the automated collection truck will be tagged and scheduled for collection.
- All recyclable items should be placed inside the **GREEN** cart. Cardboard must be cut to size to fit inside the cart. Cardboard that cannot fit inside may be placed along side of the **GREEN RECYCLE CART** and sized no greater than 4 feet x 4 feet.
- Overflow can be placed in cardboard boxes or Kraft paper bags.

PROPER CART PLACEMENT FOR AUTOMATED PICK-UP

Using your carts requires proper placement on the day of your scheduled collection. Please follow the guidelines below. Thank you for your assistance.

Please Do This



Set carts out no later than 6:00 am on the day of your scheduled collection.
Place carts with lid opening facing the street.
(the handle away from street)



Set carts next to curb or edge, **3 feet apart**, or in the street, wheels touching the curb or edge.



Have **at least 3 feet** between the carts, and from trees, posts, vehicles, mailboxes and basketball hoops.

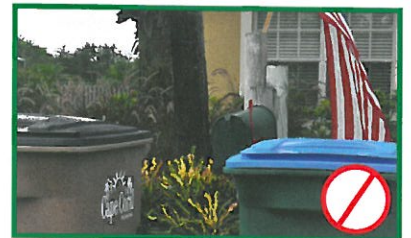


Do not place carts under trees. Automated cart pickup requires up to 15 feet overhead clearance.

Have at least 3 feet between the carts and the vehicles.
Place carts in the street with wheels touching curb or edge.

RECYCLING BIN INSTRUCTIONS

Please put only the following listed materials into the **GREEN** recycling collection container:

ALL PAPER

- Magazines • Junk Mail • Envelopes • Newspaper • Flyers • Brochures
- Writing, Typing and Computer Paper
- Books • Phone Books

Preparation:

- Just put clean, dry paper into the bin.

Items Not Accepted:

- Wet, waxed or soiled paper
- Used paper towels and plates
- Carbon paper
- Shredded Paper
- Metallic Paper

CARDBOARD

- Corrugated Boxes • Paper Tubes
- Cereal Boxes • Wrapping Paper
- File Folders • Poster Board

Preparation:

- Flatten Boxes
- Remove plastic liners and all styrofoam packing material.

Items Not Accepted:

- Wet or soiled cardboard

GLASS

- Juice, Pop & Soda • Water Bottles
- Beer & Wine Bottles • Food Jars

Preparation:

- Remove lids
- Rinse to remove residue.
- Do not break glass.

Items Not Accepted:

- Light bulbs
- Window glass, drinking glasses or mirrors

METALS

- Tin Food Cans • Aluminum
- Beverage Cans • Aluminum Foil

Preparation:

- Empty and rinse cans to remove all food residue.

Items not Accepted:

- Cans used for chemicals or paints
- Appliances, power tools or batteries
- Scrap Metal

PLASTICS

- Plastic Bottles used for Milk, Juice, Soap and Soft Drinks

Preparation:

- Rinse containers to remove residue.

Items Not Accepted:

- Containers used for chemicals or automotive products (oil, antifreeze, etc.)
- Rubber products
- Styrofoam cups and packing material
- Photographic film
- Plastic bags
- Polyvinyl sheeting
- Heat shrink wrapping

DO NOT put the following materials into the recycling collection bin: **Liquids • Food • Waste • Fabrics • Wood • Styrofoam**

YARD WASTE PREPARATION

- Yard Waste may be placed in a garbage can, paper or plastic garbage bags.
- Can size should be 40 gallons or less with tight fitting lid and handles on each side.
- Weight of can should not exceed 50 lbs.
- Place leaves, grass, twigs, etc. in bags or containers as described above.
- Palm fronds do not need to be bundled, but stacked neatly.
- Tie and bundle tree limbs and branches that are smaller than 4 inches in diameter and less than 6 feet in length.
- Limbs that exceed 4 inches and not greater than 6 feet in length or 50 pounds may be set out and neatly stacked.
- Items that are not prepared will require a charge for removal.
