CART PLACEMENT

Automated collection requires special attention when setting out your carts!

Be sure your recycling and garbage carts' wheels are facing the house within two feet of curb.

Leave a two foot space between carts and obstructions like mailboxes, parked cars, utility poles, etc. All garbage should be bagged and fit inside your cart with the lid fully closed.



Never block streets, sidewalks, mailboxes or driveways.

RECYCLE MORE

New blue recycle bins will not be emptied until your regular scheduled date in October. Reduce the amount of waste going to the landfill by recycling as many items as possible. (Please rinse all food, drink, or other residues from ttems first.)

A new 96-gallon cart and recycle bin will be delivered to each resident starting on August 27 to September 29. Pickup days will not change, but pickup times may vary.

Continue to use your current cart until your first designated service day in Oct. New carts will not be emptied prior to that start day, so it is important not to use them until that time.

Put your old cart at the curb upside down for pickup after October 1.
