

RECYCLE MORE

New blue recycle carts will not be emptied until your first designated start date in September. Please refer to your solid waste calendar or visit www.indiantrail.org for more information. Reduce the amount of waste going to the landfill by recycling as many items as possible.

(Please rinse all food, drink, or other residues from items first.)

NEW! BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 2012, PLEASE RECYCLE THESE ITEMS

- Empty Aerosol Cans (no paint cans)
- All Plastics 1-7
(no Styrofoam, bags, or wrap)
- Wide-Mouth Plastic Containers & Lids
- Rigid Plastic Containers & Small Hard Plastic Toys
- Milk & Juice Cartons, & Juice Boxes
- Shredded Paper *(placed in clear bag)*



PLEASE CONTINUE TO RECYCLE THESE ITEMS

- Aluminum Cans
- Metal Food Cans & Lids
- Glass Bottles & Jars
- Cereal & Food Boxes
- Cardboard Boxes Flattened
- Mixed Paper, Newspapers with Inserts, & Junk Mail
- Paperback Books
- Magazines & Phonebooks
- Spiral Paper Cans
(with plastic lids detached)



NOT TO BE RECYCLED

- Pizza Boxes
- Styrofoam
- Paint Cans
- Plastic Bags

CART PLACEMENT

Automated collection requires special attention when setting out your carts!

Be sure your recycling and garbage carts' wheels are facing the house within 3 feet of curb.



Leave a 2-foot space between your two carts and between the carts and obstructions like mailboxes, parked cars, utility poles, etc. All garbage must be bagged and fit inside your cart with the lid fully closed.



Never block streets, sidewalks, mailboxes or driveways.

NEW CARTS

Two new 96-gallon carts (*1 for solid waste, 1 for recyclables*) will be delivered to each resident during the month of



Continue to use your current recycle bin until your first designated service day in Sept. New blue carts will not be emptied prior to that start day, so it is important not to use them until that time.

If you wish to have your current recycle bin repurposed or recycled after new service begins, please set it out by the curb on your recycling collection day.

AUTOMATED COLLECTION

RECYCLING

Waste Pro's new, fully automated collection vehicles will collect your recycling every-other-week. Please reference your calendar for collection week or visit www.indiantrail.org for more information.

GARBAGE

Garbage will be picked up every week, as usual.

NEW CURBSIDE YARD WASTE COLLECTION

- Yard Waste means grass, leaves, limbs, trimmings, or other plant or vegetative material.
- Collected curbside bi-weekly on your regular service day. Material must be bundled and tied or put into **clear** plastic or **paper** bags. Please reference your calendar for collection week.
- Limbs must be no longer than 4 feet in length and 2 inches in diameter.
- Expanded leaf pick up (*up to 50 bags per pick up*) will be provided during peak periods. Please check Town website for collection schedule.

WHY CLEAR PLASTIC BAGS?



Clear bags allow the service crew to verify contents, and confirm that no garbage or other prohibited items are inside the bag.

REMEMBER

- Yard Waste is prohibited from municipal landfills in the State of North Carolina.
- Please do not put any yard waste material in your household solid waste cart.

NEW CURBSIDE BULK & ELECTRONIC WASTE PICKUP

Indian Trail now offers curbside bulk and e-waste pick-up 3 times a year. Curbside pick-up will occur the months of January, June and October. Please refer to your solid waste calendar for your scheduled pick-up week or visit www.indiantrail.org for more information. Bulk pick-up will occur on your normal service day of that week.



BULK WASTE

Bulky waste refers to items too large to fit into recycle or garbage carts. (*appliances, furniture, bicycles, tires, scrap metal, etc.*)

E-WASTE



Electronic waste is anything with a computer circuit board. (*cell phones, computers, radios, televisions, etc.*)

Indian Trail residents may also bring e-waste and bulk items to the town's annual Trash and Recycling Drop-off Day held April 27, 2013. Waste Pro offers fee based, specialized year round service upon request.
