Waste Management will complete its last services during the week of January 18-22 and will be removing their carts. If you place materials in your new Waste Pro carts, please keep in mind that they will not be serviced until the week of January 25th, 2021.

If your scheduled pickup day falls on one of the above holidays there will be a one-day delay.

SERVICE SCHEDULE

Garbage Services

Mondays – Weekly
Beginning January 25, 2021

Recycling Services:

Wednesdays – Bi-Weekly
Beginning January 27, 2021

Normal services will be provided between the hours of 7am and 7pm. Your carts must be placed at the curb prior to 7am. It is suggested that you place your carts at the curb the night before service is to be provided.

CONTAINERS

RECYCLING

Your residential recycling is collected every other Wednesday, with the first pickup taking place on January 27th, 2021.

The following items may be recycled:

- Aluminum, steel and tin cans including soda cans, foil casserole pans and pie plates
- Plastic bottles including milk jugs and water, soda, shampoo, soap, and laundry detergent bottles
- Newspapers, broken down cardboard boxes (excluding pizza boxes) that will fit in the cart, brown paper bags, telephone books, magazines and other miscellaneous residential paper

Items should be rinsed and placed loose inside of your bin.



We are unable to accept tires, aerosol cans, styrofoam, hoses and glass.

If your recycling is not in compliance, it will not be picked up. The Waste Pro driver will place a tag on your front door informing you of the specific reason(s) for the rejection.
