



Waste Pro encourages all customers who are interested in recycling to participate in the recycle program. Below are some frequently asked questions and guidelines as to what can and cannot be recycled.

Frequently asked questions

How are recycle materials processed?

- Waste Pro currently collects over 100 tons of recycle material each month. Recycled materials are delivered to the Central landfill in Milton then transported to the ECUA MRF (Materials Recovery Facility) located in Pensacola. They are then separated and prepared for distribution.

How often are recycle carts serviced?

- Waste Pro provides weekly recycle service for those who subscribe to the program.

What size cart is provided?

- Waste Pro provides one-96 gal blue cart. Recycle materials must be placed inside the cart and at the curb by 7:00 am on your service day.

Do items have to be separated?

- All acceptable recycle items can be placed in blue cart. No need to separate.

What items can be recycled?

- Below is a list of acceptable and prohibited materials

Acceptable items

- Glass; any color
- Newspaper & Inserts
- Cardboard
- Boxboard (cereal, cake & cracker boxes, etc.)
- Plastic bottles
- Plastics No. 1 & 2
- Plastic Milk Jugs; 2-Liters (including caps)
- Aluminum Cans & Lids
- Tin and Steel Cans & Lids
- Metal Pots, Pans & Cookie Sheets
- Pet food cans (no plastic liner)

Prohibited Items

- **Polystyrene products (Styrofoam®)**
- Plastic bags - Please check with your local grocery stores to see if they collect plastic bags for recycling
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Pet food bags
- Ice cream cartons
- Waxy/paper milk cartons
- Aerosol cans
- Juice boxes or bags
- Garbage or yard waste
- Garden hoses
- Window blinds
- Tarps
- Carpeting or rugs
- Construction materials
